Overfoord of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto put

THIS aboves writen will was proved at Westminster before the Judges for
probate of wills and grantinge Administration lawfully authorized. The Seabouth
Day of February in the yeare of our Lord God according to the computation of the
Church of England Our Edward six hundred fiftie and three. By the oath of Margarott
the Relict of the said Deceased and Excutrix named in the said will to whom was granted
Administration of all and singular the goods chattels and debts of the said Deceased. Shes
being first legally sworn (by vertue of a Commission) well and faithfully to admittie the same:.

The first Day of December in the yeare of our Lord God Our Edward six hundred
fiftie three I Edward Savage of the parish of Crobryglood in the Countie of Montgomery
beinge sick in bodie but of perfect mynd and memory (praise bee given to Almighty God)
Do make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge committinge my
Soule unto the mercifull hande of Almighty God And my bodie to be buryed in the parish
Church of Crobryglood at the oversight of my Excutrix and friends And of all my worldly
goods I dispose ad folloiweth In primis I give and bequeath unto the repairation of the parish
Church of Crobryglood aforesaid the summe of Tenne shillings. Item I give unto Thomas
Savage myne eldest Sonne the summe of Seabouthstone poundes to bee paid unto him by my
Excutrix at such tyme as Thomas Savage of the same shall accomplish the age of one and twentie
yeares. Upon this condition that the said Thomas Savage my Sonne shall first make and
Seale unto John Savage my second Sonne a Release of his title to my widdowinge in Bodaiork
And in case hee shall refuse soe to doe I bequeath unto him the summe of ffourtie poundes
to bee paid unto him at the tyme aboves mentioned. Together wth those two widdowes in Bodaiork
which were purchasid by my father commonly knowne by the names of Colobor and Arbo
sark and noe more in respect hee hath had a portion of mee abroad. Item I give and bequeath
unto Andrew Savage my third Sonne the summe of ffiftie poundes to bee paid unto him
wth in the space of one yeare next after my decease. Item I bequeath unto Joane Savage my
Daughter the summe of Threescore poundes to bee paid wth in the space of one yeare after my
decease. Item I bequeath unto Edward Savage my youngest Sonne the summe of ffiftie
poundes to bee paid him wth in the space of ffive yeares after my decease. And also I give
and bequeath unto the said Edward Savage my Sonne a Tenne kilds latelie erected and one
parcell of lande therunto adjoyninge situate and beinge in Koton Barack in the said parish
of Crobryglood wth all appurtenances and appoyntments whatsover thers unto belonginge in
the tenure and occupation of John Bredde my Nephewe wth the rent thereof duringe his
lease And soe to the said Edward Savage and his heires for ever. And my will is that the
said Edward Savage shall bee maintained by my wife wth Apparell fitt for an Apprentice
untill such tyme as hee shall have received his said portion of ffiftie poundes. Item I bequeath
unto Margarott Savage my wife the summe of ffourtie poundes to bee paid unto her immediatly
after my Sonne John Savage shall marrye. Item I give unto her all my kilds should stuffe to
dispose of amongst my children Exceptinge manifeste Unpboarded pressed Cabled bodd stodd
and ymplement of husbandrie which I give unto the said John Savage. Item I give and
bequeath unto the said John Savage my second Sonne all and singular my lande and Tenent
wth all and singular kilds barnes buildings and Appurtenances whatsover thers unto
belonginge purchasid by mee of David Ellyd before of ane. And of Edward Brand of

To have and to holde all the said promised unto him and his heirs
 for ever excepting one three penny taffe or parcel of mowddon ground lately purchased
 of the said Edward Evans, and lying at the end of Levid Millend. Farms in Bodacoth
 which said parcel of mowddon ground I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Edward
 Savage, to have and to holde to him and his heirs for ever. Item I do bequeath unto the said
 John Savage all my good chattell and shall not by me formerly bequeathed And also all
 my debt by specialtie or writ out together with all debts and graces now in the barne and
 graving upon the promised. Item I give unto my Daughter Audrey Goodwynne the summe
 of ffive poundes in lieu of a childre part, in regard she hath received a greater portion
 already. Item I give unto Margarett Savage my Grand Daughter the summe of ffive poundes
 to be paid when she shall accomplish the age of ffifteen yeres. Item I give unto Thomas
 Savage Anne Savage Audrey Savage and Jane Savage my Grandchildren the summe of
 Tenne shillinges a peece to be paid with in ffewer yeres next after my decease. Item I give
 unto Edward Goodwynne my Grandson the summe of Tenne shillinges to be paid with in
 ffewer yeres next after my decease. Item I bequeath unto Thomas Goodwynne
 Margarett Goodwynne and Margory Goodwynne my Grandchildren the summe of Tenne
 shillinges a peece to be paid with in the space of ffewer yeres after my decease. Item I
 give unto Thomas Savage my Nephew one fower yere olde redd Colt. Item I give unto
 Richard Dwell the younger Two shillinges. Item I give unto Richard Roger Enolis pence.
 Item I give unto Margarett Levid Enolis pence. Item I make John Savage my second
 Sonne my sole Executor of this my last will and Testament, hoping hee will see the same
 will and trulie performed And I do nominate and appointe my Brother in lawe Thomas
 Hall Levid Easton and my Nephew John Brood to be Overseers of the same. In witness
 whereof I have hereunto put my hand and Seal the Day and yere first above written.
 Edward Savage. Sealed and delivered in the sight and presence of Thomas Hall his
 mark. John Brood his mark.

Be it remembered that before the enscaling hereof a word was blotted out in the ninth
 line, and the word (Honour) interlined in stead thereof, the word (by my wife) interlined
 in the nynteenth line. And the word (the summe of Tenne shillinges a peece) in the
 thirtieth fourth line. And hereunto Thomas Hall his mark. John Brood his mark. /:

 declare this my present last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge (that is

 decentlie in the little Church yarde of great St. Bartholomew London And I will that
 such Debt which I shall owe to any person or persons at the tyme of my decease shall be
 paid with as much convenientie as may be after my decease And after my debt paid
 and fmovall charge discharged I give and dispose my good and shalloll, in manner
 and forme followinge (that is to say) I give to my Mother Katherine Wellington forty
 shillinges And I order and appointe, that my said Mother shall have and holde ren free
 duringe her naturall life, the house and ground which she holdeth of mee situate in
 Galber hill in the Countie of Hertsford And I give to my wife Margery one third of
 my personall Estate according to the custome of the Citie of London And the other
 two third of my personall Estate I give and devise to my Children Michael and
 Elizabeth
